



2007-2008 REQUEST FOR CANCELLATION OF RECITAL

Cancellation Policy

The following are considered legitimate reasons for cancellation:

- 1) Injury or illness (physician's note required)
- 2) Family emergency
- 3) 'Act of God' (weather catastrophes, travel emergencies)

The following are *not* legitimate reasons for cancellation:

- 1) Repertoire not ready for performance
- 2) Schedule conflicts; this includes conflicts with outside engagements or unforeseen conflicts with a faculty member's schedule
- 3) Problems with assisting artists

If you cancel a Kilbourn Hall recital without a legitimate reason, you will not be allowed to schedule in Kilbourn Hall for the remainder of the current semester and for the entire semester following the cancellation.
