

## Dean Named at Eastman School of Music

(Rochester, N.Y.) - Douglas Lowry, currently dean of the College-Conservatory of Music at the University of Cincinnati, was named dean of the Eastman School of Music.

He begins the position August 1.


University of Rochester President Joel Seligman said in a press release, "Doug Lowry has been an extraordinarily successful academic leader as well as a composer and conductor of note. He will bring to Eastman the leadership, musicality, and drive to provide new energy to this nation's leading school of music."







Lowry's compositional premiers and other musical work have taken him to venues throughout the United States and Asia as a guest conductor and clinician of orchestras and wind ensembles.

The search for a new Eastman dean followed the resignation of James Undercofler, now president and chief executive officer of the Philadelphia Orchestra.
