04.13.02 Financial Aid and Academic Warning

Students who do not meet the minimum standards for Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) as defined above will be placed on Financial Aid and Academic Warning Status. Students on this status will be notified in writing by the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs of the requirements which must be satisfied to remove themselves from this Warning.

Students on Financial Aid and Academic Warning Status will face a financial penalty and will lose some or all of any institutional merit scholarship they may be receiving (see 4.13.07 Impact on Meritbased Aid). Students cannot be on Warning for more than one semester, or else they risk suspension or dismissal from their studies at Eastman.
